



Brampton Springdale is one of five neighbourhoods identified by the Region of Peel and the United Way of Peel as lacking adequate health and social services delivery. In 2012, the Peel Newcomer Strategy Group (PNSG) met with these neighbourhoods to create a more permanent solution in each area. At the time, Punjabi Community Health Services (PCHS) was the only agency with a physical location in Brampton Springdale. PNSG identified PCHS as the lead agency to launch a joint network of service delivery within Springdale, and once launched to provide ongoing administrative and logistical support for the network. The Brampton Springdale Network (BSN) was then formed in March 2012. Throughout the years the BSN held meetings and provided services out of Louis Arbour Secondary School. In 2019 PCHS was able to lease unit 109 at their 50 Sunny Meadow Blvd location which would act as the new community hub space. As of June 2022 the space is now open for services and programming.
