

Care for Newcomer Children (CNC)

- **Objective:** To ensure that newcomer parents with settlement needs can concentrate on their needs to be addressed by the Settlement Counselor; while their children receive a safe and nurturing environment to spend time in meaningful ways
 - Clients are given an orientation session which helps them understand the program and activities for their children
 - CNC program is tailored for needs of each child which allows them to grow and develop at their own pace
- **Eligibility:** Children of clients served under IRCC programs
- **Referrals:** Through PCHS' Settlement Counselors
- **Modality:** Currently programs are offered in-person and virtually
- **Locations:** PCHS' Brampton Office ONLY
- **Languages:** English, Hindi and Punjabi
